### UPDATE ON ACES

Recently, the ASHRAE Continuing Education Studies (ACES) made an administrative change. As of July 1, 1984, ASHRAE Headquarters will be responsible for all aspects of the program. Previously, the Educational Testing Service (ETS) which assisted in developing ACES also administered the program.

What does this change mean? It means that from now on, you will purchase your ACES modules from ASHRAE. Please send your registration form and check directly to ASHRAE.

This change also means that ASHRAE will grade all your ACES modules. Your confidential results will be mailed directly and only to you.

Your ACES benefits remain the same. For each completed ACES module, you earn:

- 2.0 Continuing Education Units
- Certificate of Completion
- PAOE Points for our Chapter

### ASHRAE ENERGY AWARDS

The ASHRAE Energy Awards recognizes outstanding achievements in the field of energy management. Entrants must be ASHRAE members who played significant roles in the design or development of the energy-conserving aspects of a project. A project must have been in successful operation for at least one year, with actual energy consumption data for those twelve months submitted for evaluation.

**Entries to the Society competition must first have been declared winners in an ASHRAE Chapter Competition**, followed by winning at the regional level, except in the case of international entries.

Winners of chapter and regional competitions will be the focus of publicity generated at the local level and will receive peer recognition from the presentation of awards at chapter and regional meetings.
