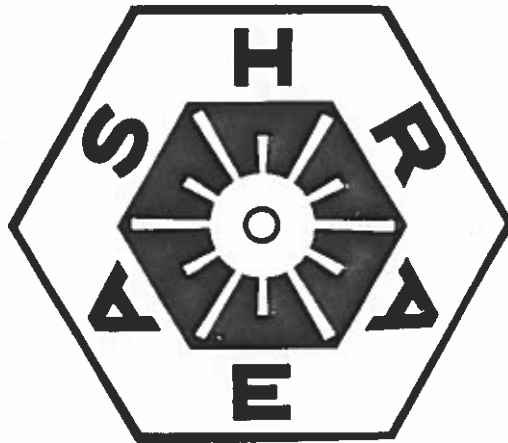

The 1990 - 91 year was an active and productive year for the London Ontario Chapter of ASHRAE.

The main themes for the year were:

1. Chapter Growth
2. Membership Participation

Chapter growth was encouraged by sending Chapter Bulletins to all ASHRAE Society Members within 60 miles of the city. We believe that if this line of communication is kept open, we will attract more members from outside the city limits. We also offer an attractive fee schedule for out of town members who would be unable to attend our regular meetings.

One of the major success stories of the year was the presentation of technical sessions before our regular meetings. These sessions were well attended and well received. They can be geared to present specific information to a specific part of the membership, educating a member in an area that he or she may have an interest.

An on going problem with our Chapter is one of size, we do not have sufficient people to have a chairman and members for our various committees. Since committees consist of only the chairman a career change or transfer, leaves the chapter without that committee. This will continue to be problem for the London Chapter.

Another success story for the London Chapter is a joint trade show with the London & District Construction Association. This show produced revenue of Two Thousand, Three Hundred and Nineteen Dollars (\$2,319.00) for the Chapter, allowing us to expand our mailings and send additional members to the CRC.

A first time donation of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) was given to ASHRAE Research from the funds generated by our participation in this show.

This year has been another successful year for the London Chapter and with the present members on the Board of Governors, I see nothing but continued success in the future.

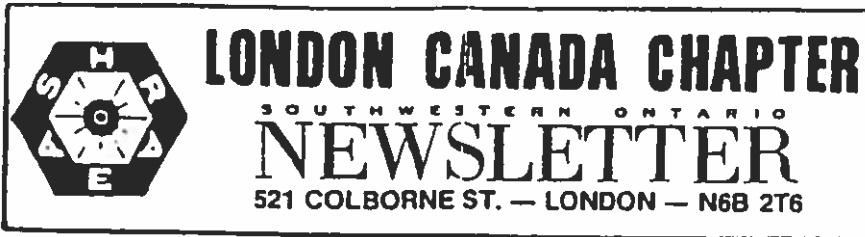

In April a presentation on Alternate Fuels is planned.


