Topic: Energy Management

Ontario consumers continually face new choices on how to effectively manage their building energy costs. On May 1, 2002, how to purchase electricity can be added to the list of options. The energy decisions made by commercial, institutional and industrial owners can result in thousands to millions of dollar saved or lost. To further understand these issues, we will look at the two determining factors which should be a part of all energy decision-making; energy pricing and energy consumption. Knowledge of the deregulated energy markets, including rates structures and energy purchasing options, is essential to finding the "right" energy at the "right" price. Understanding how energy will be or is used in a facility is vital to looking for more efficient or effective way to use it. Lastly, awareness of how energy consumption can effect energy pricing can be crucial in making the final energy decision. Better understanding the issues that impact energy pricing and consumption is a prerequisite to effective energy management.
