Since entering the industry in January 2006, he has leveraged his experience as an estimator and project manager in his family's mechanical contracting company to provide practical and effective engineering solutions. Niss is a certified HVAC Designer by ASHRAE, the first in Canada to earn this designation, and holds a Certified Engineering Technologist (C.E.T.) designation with OACETT. He is actively involved with ASHRAE at both local and society levels, contributing to several technical committees and study guides. Since March 2020, Niss has been part of the instruction team at the Heating, Refrigeration, and Air Conditioning Institute of Canada (HRAI) and joined the HVAC Technology Program at George Brown College in September 2020 as a partial load Professor.



For the last two years, Niss has been studying Arctic and Remote Community design, including courses at the University of Alaska Anchorage. He has traveled to Alaska and the Northwest Territories to attend cold climate conferences and study the built environment in arctic communities. Additionally, he has completed HVAC and plumbing designs in Nunavut, bringing his experience to some of the most challenging environments.

Hello ASHRAE London Members,


