Air Handling Unit Design and Canadian Healthcare Standard CSA Z317.2

The CSA-Z317.2 standard, titled "Special requirements for heating, ventilation, and air-conditioning (HVAC) systems in health care facilities," provides comprehensive guidelines for the planning, design, construction, commissioning, operation, and maintenance of HVAC systems in health care settings. Air handling unit (AHU) design is crucial for maintaining optimal indoor air quality and patient safety.

In this presentation, we will explore CSA Z317.2:24, the 6th and most current edition, and the key considerations for AHU design as outlined in the standard. Topics will include facility classification, design criteria, AHU construction, and specifications for heating, cooling, filtration, humidification, and energy recovery.
